Hi Maeve, in the case I was dealing with at KOD the woman was made a ward of court on application of the nuns, through a firm of solicitors who were then appointed her committee. The woman in question had living family members who were not told about any of this at the time. When they enquired about what had happened to the money, they were told that the redress was being paid into court and the woman's care was being paid for out of her pension. We were trying to get a clearer picture of exactly where the money was going but we were absolutely stonewalled by the committee. I didn't take that case with me from KOD so I don't know what's happened since.
