RE: Exhumations at St. Mary's Private Graveyard High Park, Drumcondra, Dublin 9

The exhumations at High Park commenced on Monday, 23/8/93 and were carried out by Patrick Massey & Sons Ltd., The Coombe, Undertakers. Prior to commencement, a map of the graveyard was made to record the location of the plots and the names of those interred, as indicated by the grave markings, i.e. white crosses. We were advised that the crosses were removed and replaced on occasion to facilitate funerals, grass cutting etc. so while they indicated the names of those interred in the graveyard they may not be totally accurate as to the location or contents of each grave.

The graveyard was screened at the rear wall to block the view from the Regency Hotel, Swords Road. The remaining boundries were either screened naturally by trees, hedging etc. or did not require screening. Access to the graveyard was via a gateway located within the convent grounds which was locked at all times, access being confined to those directly involved with the exhumations only.

The exhumations were carried out using a mechanical digger for opening graves, and manually as appropriate. The disinterred remains and all timbers were placed in plastic lined coffins which were then sealed and marked with an identifying name and coffin no. The name and number were then recorded. The coffins were transported to Glasnevin Crematorium or held in a secure storage area adjacent to the graveyard pending transport to the crematorium.

The exhumation proceedings were stopped twice by the Eastern Health Board:-

(1) 24/8/93: to ensure that all coffins being sent to the crematorium would be cremated within 48 hours (as required by the 1st Department of the Environment Licence). The no. being exhumed at that time was in excess of the capablility of the crematorium the following day. The cremations were also subject to delays as the crematorium had to await consent forms from the Coroners Office in order to proceed with each cremation - this organisation of the consent forms was a function of the undertakers.

The exhumations were allowed recommence at 8a.m. 25/8/93.

(2) 28/8/93: 133 remains were exhumed i.e. the number permitted by the Department of the Environment licence and the additional licence was required.

All exhumed remains except one, were transported to the crematorium and cremated within 48 hours as required by the exhumation licence. The remains of Elizabeth (1983) were sought by her family. Under advice from the Department of the Environment the remains were handed over to the family Glasnevin on Wednesday 2/9/93.

The 2nd Department of the Environment exhumation licence, which permitted the exhumation of all human remains interred at the graveyard, was granted on the 2nd September, 1993 and the exhumations recommenced and were completed on Thursday 3rd September, 1993. An additional 22 remains were exhumed. The procedure regarding recoffining and transporting to the crematorium was followed as before. To ensure that all human remains were exhumed from the graveyard, a trench was dug accross the length of the unmarked ground to the front of the graveyard. All soil removed was clean and there was no evidence of any further unmarked burials within the area of the graveyard.

The final day of exhumations was attended by Dr. John Harbison, State Pathologist (for scientific/research purposes).

Identification of remains: Where possible the remains were identified by the coffin breast-plate. 24 remains were identified by name and/or date in this way. Ref List 3.

Most remains were identified by the grave markings i.e. a white metal cross with name plates, unless the nature of the original coffin eg. the presence of plastic lining or the positive identification of an upper coffin, indicated that the grave marking was incorrect. In such cases the remains were maked "unknown".

Several recent burials were i.e. 1970's/1980's were unmarked in the graveyard. Fortunately, legible breast-plates were found for most. In list 2 an attempt is made to correlate the religious or lay name as found at the grave or coffin with the religious or lay name listed in the licence.

In total 155 human remains were exhumed from the graveyard and subsequently cremated.

All exhumations and removals to the crematorium were supervised by an Environmental Health Officer, Eastern Health Board. All exhumations and removals were carried outwith due care and decency and in such a manner as not to endanger public health.

The requirements of the Environmental Health Office, as specified prior to the commencement of the exhumations, were complied with.
