- 1. Each exhumation shall be carried out within twelve months of the date of this licence under the supervision of a person appointed for the purpose of such supervision by Dublin Corporation and in accordance with such directions as may be given by the Eastern Health Board with respect to matters affecting or likely to affect public health.
- Each of the said remains shall, as soon as possible after the exhumation, be either:
 - (a) re-interred in Glasnevin Cemetery, Glasnevin,
 Dublin 11, under the supervision of a person
 appointed for the purpose of such supervision by
 Dublin Corporation and in accordance with such
 directions as may be given by the Eastern Health
 Board with respect to matters affecting or likely
 to affect public health, or
 - (b) cremated.
